Gentlemen:

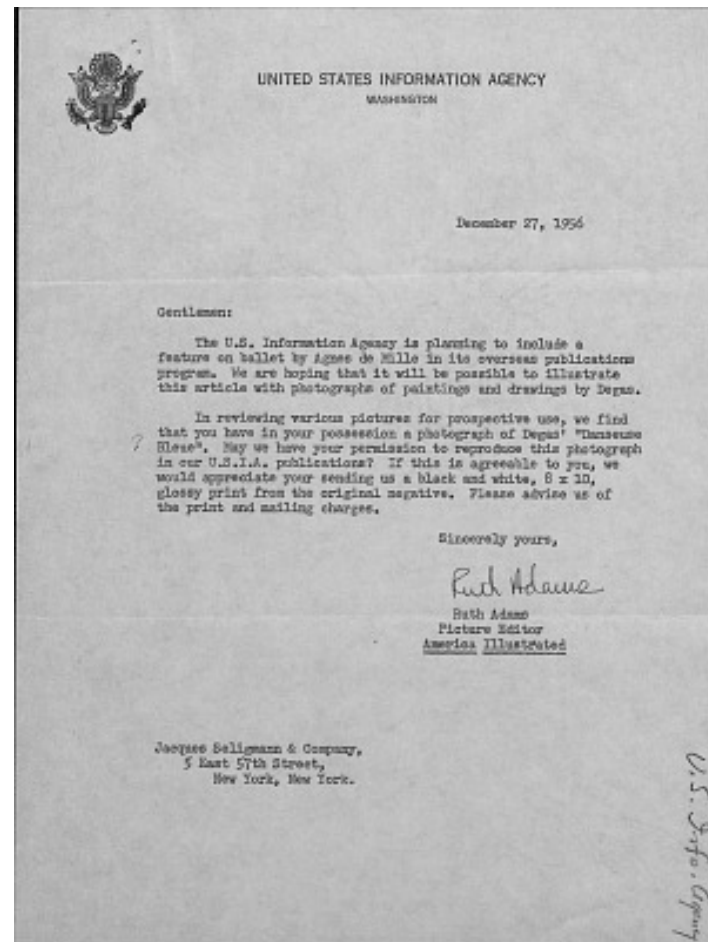
