Dear Miss Morrison:

Thank you for your promptness in acting upon our request for the "Danseuse Bleue" print,and for your efforts to locate this photograph in your records. We have made a thorough recheck of our own information, but find that our source does state that you own both the photograph and the original pastel.

The source which we have been using is the book, [[underlined]] Degas Dancers [[/underlined]], by Lillian Browse, first published in 1949 by Faber and Faber, Ltd., 24 Russell Square, London, England. (No dates are given for subsequent printings by R. MacLehose and Co., Ltd., England, and the University Press, Glasgow, Scotland.) Data pertinent to "Denseuse Bleue" is found on page 385 of this volume, in the section entitled "Notes on the Plates". We have enclosed an exact copy of this information for your convenience, and hope that it will prove of some assistant in your research.

Since we would like to go ahead with our work on the DeMille story, would you let us know as soon as possible whether you can give us any lead as to the whereabouts of the photograph? If you do find that you have the picture, of course, we would appreciate your sending us the requested 8x10 glossy prints.


Thank you once again for the consideration shown our request. We appreciate your cooperation and interest in our project.
