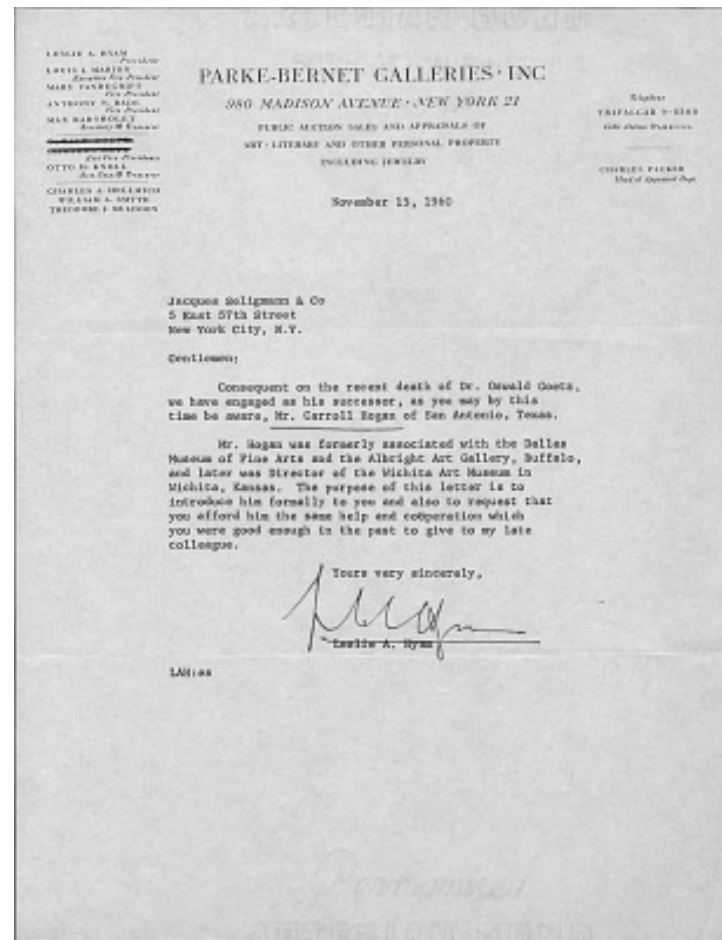
Gentlemen:
