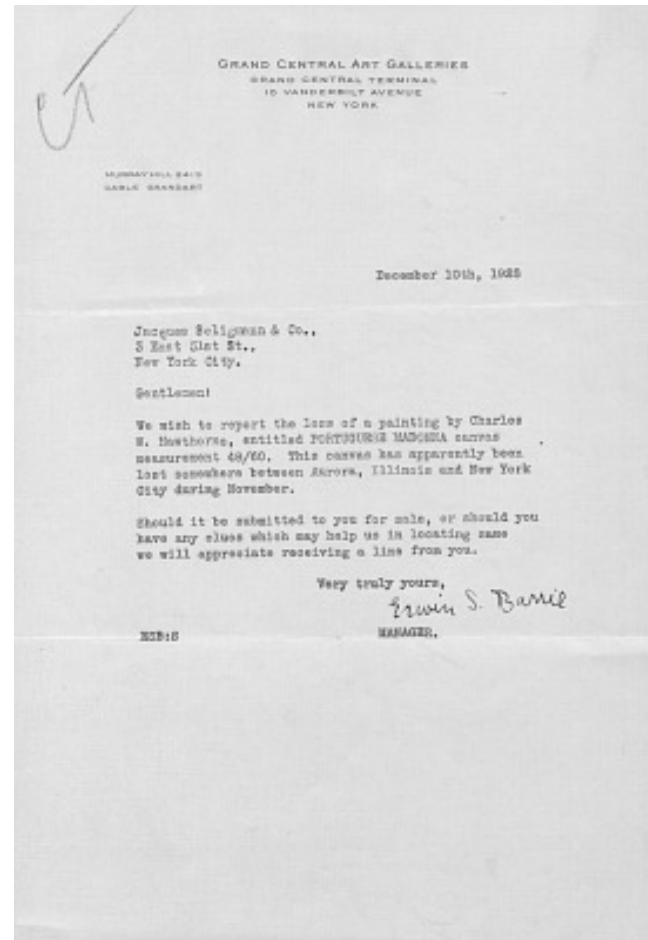
Gentlemen:
