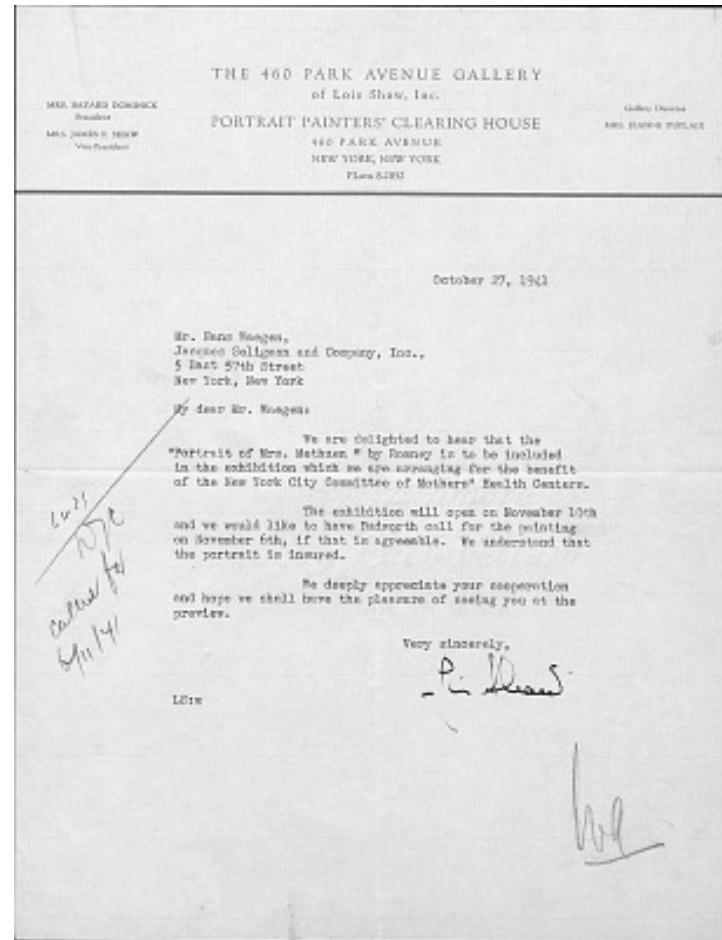
The exhibition will open on November 10th and we would like to have Budworth call for the painting on November 6th, if that is agreeable. We understand that the portrait is insured.
