Dear Phyllis:

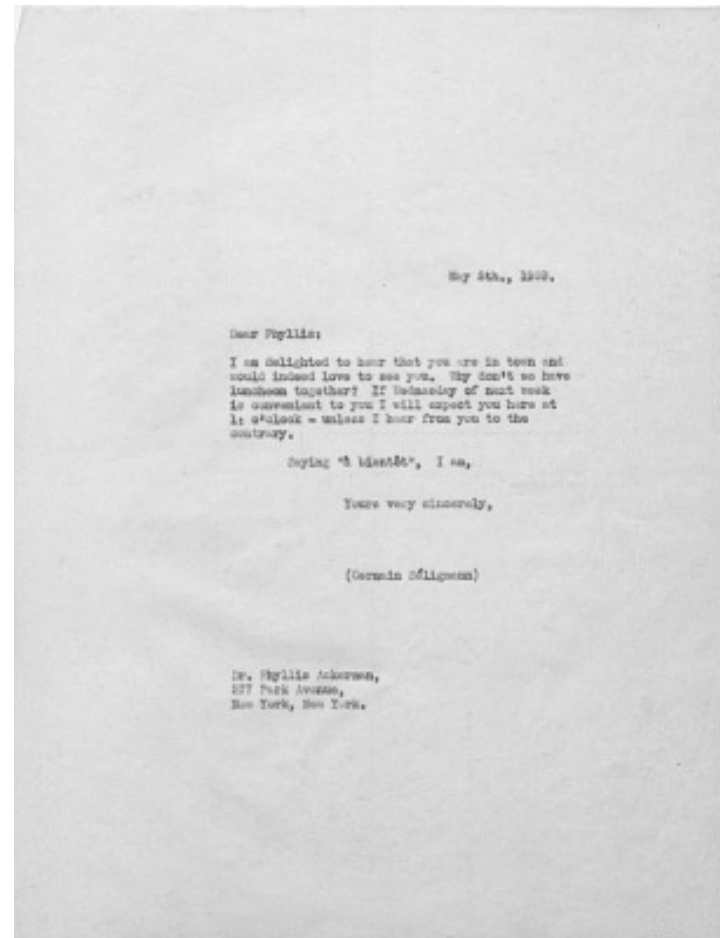
