Elle me parvient ce matin, avec une rapidité dont il y lieu de féliciter la poste.

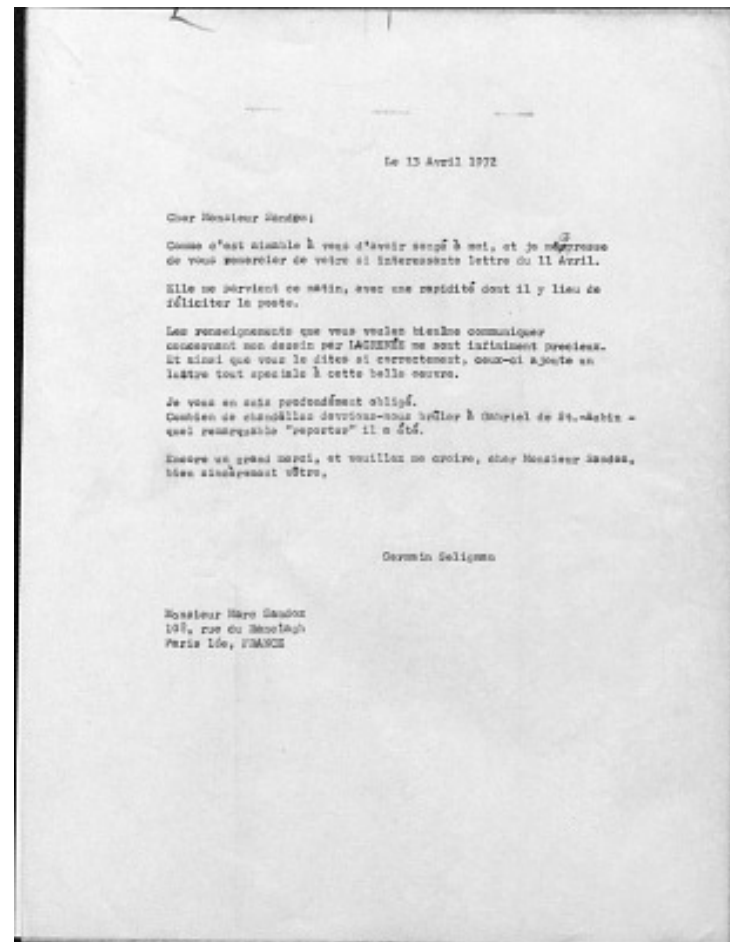
