United States and Possessions

First class (letters, etc.) - per oz. 2c
Air mail (letters, etc.) First oz. 5c. each additional oz. - 10c
Local or drop letters (where no free delivery) - per oz. 1c
Second class (newspapers, periodicals) regardless of weight or distance - each 2 oz. 1c
Third class (advertising samples, etc.) 8 oz. and under - 2 oz. 1 1/2c
Third class (books, catalogues, 24 pages) 8 oz. and under - 2oz. 1c
Fourth class (all matter except first and second class) over 8 oz. P.P. rates
Postal cards, Government, (reply cards 2c) - 1c
Private mailing cards - 1c
Registration fee (extra postage) for \$50 value - 15c
Registration fee (extra postage) for \$100 value - 20c
Each additional \$100 - 10c
Limit of indemnity \$1000
Return receipts for registered mail - 3c

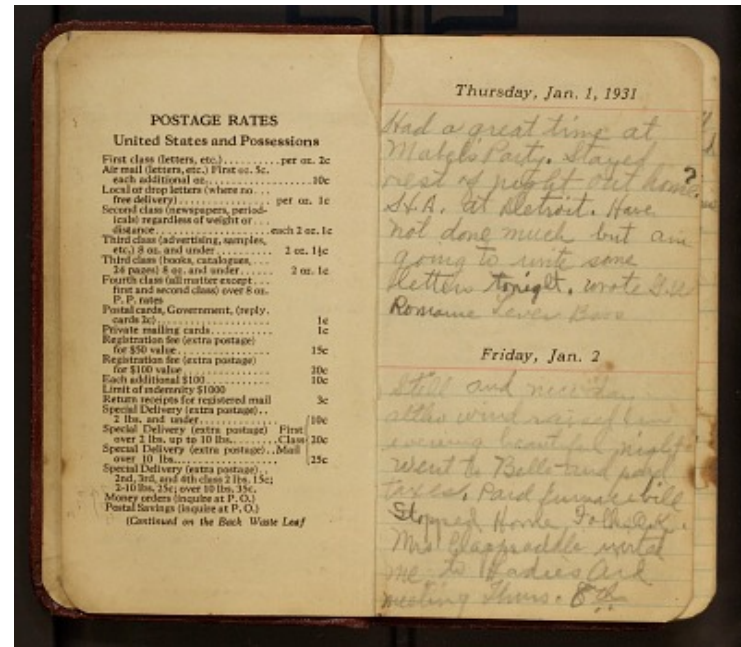
