- going into hole with 8 3/4 rock bit to 4553

10:25 AM start drilling -

- see time record - with 5000 lbs on bit making average 5' in 3 min.

12:20 PM to 4630' - hardening up a little (2' streak between 4625-30 took 6 min. - total 9 min. for 5' interval)

1:10 - distinctly harder (4640-45 in 15 min. and 4645-4648 in 10 min. with wt up to 9,000 lbs) - decide to core - circulate until [[strikethrough]] 2 PM [[/strikethrough]] 1:45 PM

[[margin note]] correction - one length overlooked --> - T.D. = 4619' = 66' below last core [[/margin note]]

[- Had 120' cuttings when rock bit was put to 4553 but driller had no difficulty getting down & believes we can take core without putting mud in hole]

- 3:15 - shut down to repair brakes.

[[underline]] 4-11:30 PM [[/underline]] RCT

Rig shut down for repairs.


8:15 started to pull pipe left in hole.

9:35 Completed pulling pipe. Then put core barrel & bit on & started running pipe into hole. Running pipe at end of shift.

June 8 - Midnight - 8AM Russell

1:04 AM Reached bottom & started coring - at 4619'
