Should you talk to Mrs. Hyde, please tell her that I would be only too pleased to carry out any bidding she may have in mind.

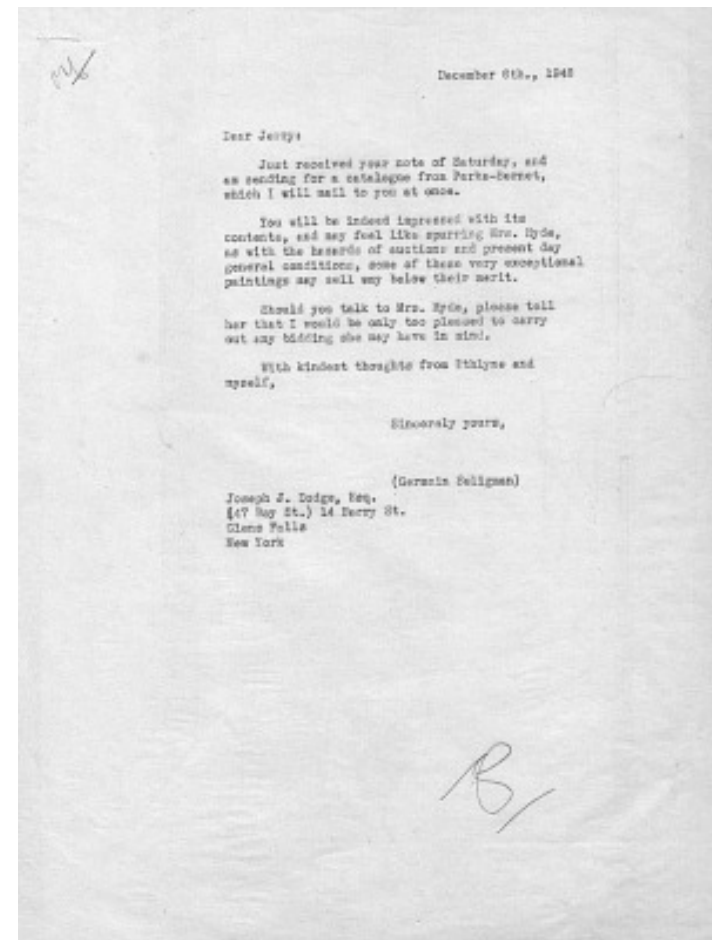
