Your Christmas card just received today, I don't know where the delay was but I am "damned" glad to get it anyway, I have tried almost every way I knew to try to locate you but without result.

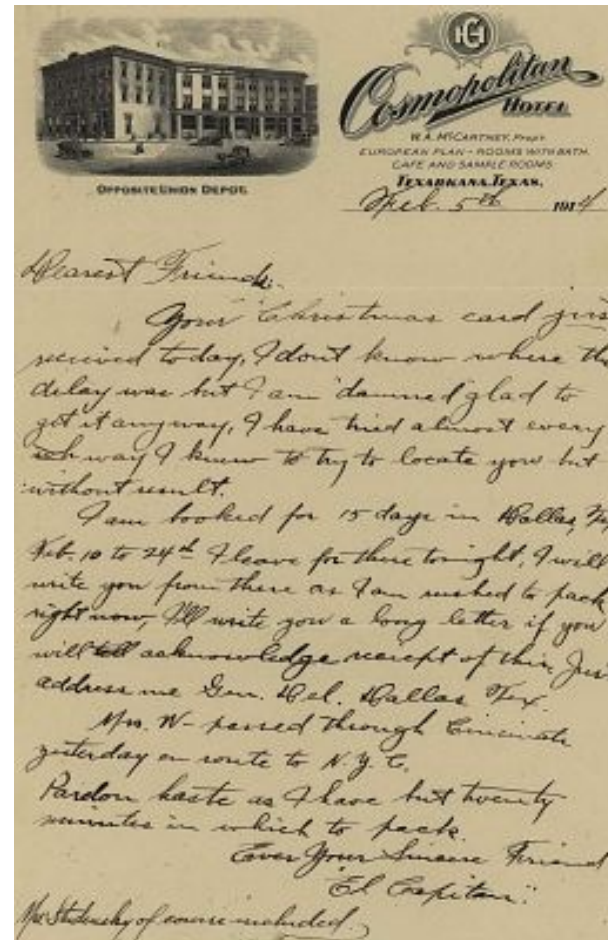
