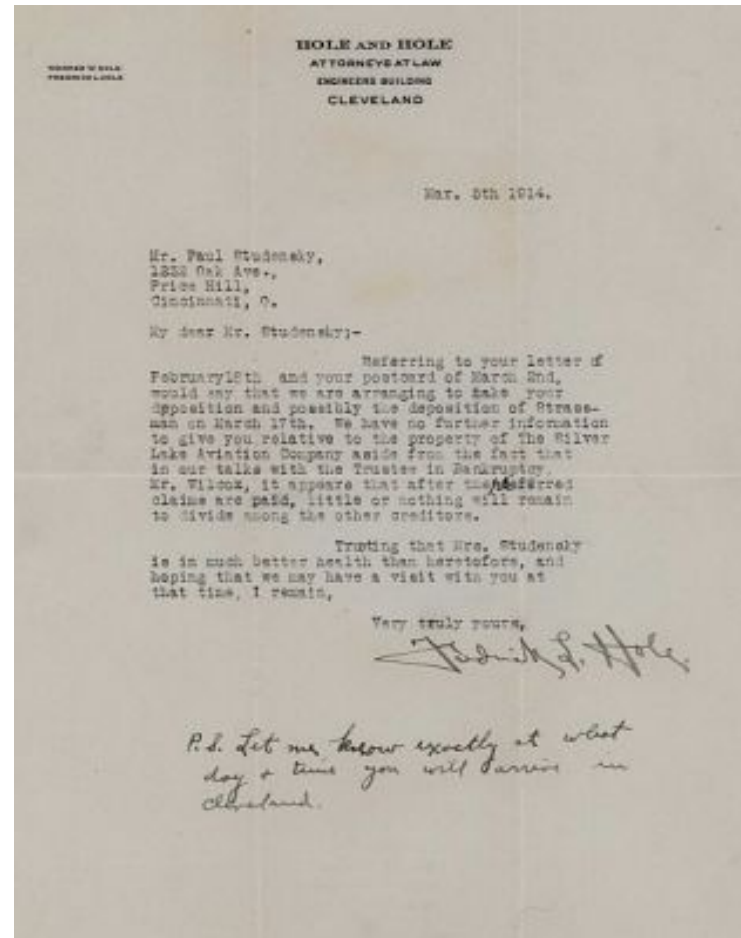
My dear Mr. Studensky:-

Referring to your letter of February 18th and your postcard of March 2nd, would say that we are arranging to take your deposition and possibly the deposition of Strassman on March 17th. We have no further information to give you relative to the property of the Silver Lake Aviation Company aside from the fact that in our talks with the Trustee in Bankruptcy, Mr. Wilcox, it appears that after the referred claims are paid, little or nothing will remain to divide among the other creditors.
