One of the other bands sent a man there to listen for it was noised through camps that a new wonderful dance- was going on - The Eagles were not Known at this time but the arrival ^[[Ta-wa-kix]] gave them power to get the Eagles - You can see Frank La Flesher sang some of the songs and the old man did not know them.
