Thereafter he produced a number of plays on Broadway, including a revival of Noel Coward's Fallen Angels, Hotel Paradiso, with Bert Lahr, Albert Camus' Caligula, and several road companies of Auntie Mame. He somehow finds time to be an avid scuba diver and pilot (Cessna 150's to Lear Jets). Last season he returned to the theatre, co-producing The Utter Glory of Morrisey Hall, starring Celeste Holm.

ALBERT W. SELDEN (Producer) for 30 years has been a devoted contributor to the national show business scene, producing on Broadway numerous musicals including Body Beautiful, The Girls Against The Boys, Come Summer, Irene, Man of La Mancha, Hallelujah, Baby! – the last two of which won many Tony and other awards – and last season's The Utter Glory of Morrissey Hall, which he co-produced. Among the plays he has produced are The Grey-Eyed People, His and Hers, starring Celeste Holm and Robert Preston, Portrait of a Queen and The Lincoln Mask. As founder and first Managing Director of the beautifully restored Goodspeed Opera House in East Haddam, Conn., Mr. Selden was involved in and responsible for more than 20 productions, musical and otherwise.
