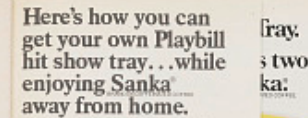
THE STARS: Fresh seafood and well-aged prime beef. House specialties include curried crabmeat, mild or spicy; jumbo shrimp stuffed with crab; fresh salmon; and a seafood combination platter of broiled lobster tail, shrimp, bay scallops and bluefish. Also - prime filet mignon, lambchops, weiner schnitzel. As Dave Wolf says, "We serve basic, honest food fit for the connoisseur."

CURTAIN TIMES: Open 7 days, holidays included. Lunch, 11:30 to 4; Dinner, 4 to 11, to 12 Friday, Saturday. 765-8981.

THE SET: Years ago this spot was a classy cabaret called the Green Room. Today it's know as Open Call, a casual after-theatre club for showfolk and showgoers - not as formal as the old days but just as much fun. It's set up like a bistro - little tables and chairs fanning out from the piano. The décor features showcards, a celebrity autograph board and theatrical spotlights, all to underline the Broadway connection.

FEATURING: A light menu of burgers, sandwiches and fried chicken. Aspiring actor and actresses can trade in their 8x10 glossies for a free drink.

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

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
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
