and is working with the brush in his left. The self-portrait extends down
below the waist to show a portion of grey-green trousers. Above he
wears a dark grey-blue jacket. It buttons high about the neck giving only
a glimpse of a white blouse at the throat. The handsome head held high
is painted full-face with his right side bathed in light. His features consist
of wide-set eyes, light-complexioned skin, a small moustache and beard
of reddish hue and brunette hair which flows back from a widow's peak
at the forehead.
