[[image - map showing the 29TH EB (BT)-ASA-TOD area including streets and buildings]]



INTRODUCTION TO THE TOKYO MAP

This MAP has been prepared especially for DEPENDENTS and ALLIED MILITARY FORCES stationed in TOKYO. It shows locations of ALLIED INSTALLATIONS and PUBLIC FACILITIES are shown by TRUE SHAPE of the building in BLACK with the CORRESPONDING NAME of the BUILDING OR ALLIED UNIT. PRINCIPAL STREETS and NUMBERED ROUTES are indicated by RED CENTER LINE and LETTER or NAME correspondingly. The principal DEPENDANT HOUSING AREAS, PERSHING HEIGHTS, the 29th EB (BT)-ASA-TOD AREA, and the central business district or MARUNOUCHI DISTRICT are shown on an enlarged scale on the back of the map as inserts. Also shown as an insert are the major HIGHWAY APPROACHES to Tokyo.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF BACK UP OF THE TOKYO MAP

To find a military installation or public facility on the map, locate it in the list below and note its cross reference number. Then in the lower or upper margin of the map, locate the letter corresponding to the first half of the cross reference; in the right or left margin of the map, locate the number corresponding to the second half of the cross reference. Following the first grid lines vertically and horizontally from the number in the margins, locate the grid square corresponding to the complete cross reference. The installation will be in the square.
