Respectfully requests that necessary repairs and other improvements be made in the Trent River Hospital. Endsmt of Lieut. A.W. McKillip. V.R.C. and Asst. Supt. Respectfully forwarded requesting permission to purchase material and employ men to make the necessary repairs and improvements recommended by Dr. A.A. Yeomans A.A. Surg. U.S.A. Endsmt of Lt. Col. S. Moore. Supt. Respectfully forwarded to Capt. Jacob F. Chur A.A.A. Genl. Approved. I have personally inspected the within named building and find the improvements spoken of by Dr. Yeomans absolutely necessary. Endsmt of Capt. Chur A.A.A.G. Respectfully referred to Bt. Lt. Col. M.K. Hogan Surg. in Chief for his recommendations. Endsmt of Dr. Hogan. Surg. in Chief. Respectfully returned to Capt. Chur A.A.A.G. with a recommendation that the improvements asked for be ordered, except the erection of the new building which I think can be dispensed with. I would recommend that the flooring of the Hospital building be relaid instead of enclosing the open space between the floor and the ground.

Respectfully returned to Actg. Asst. Surg. W.E. Day and authority given to employ the within named nurses and attendants.


