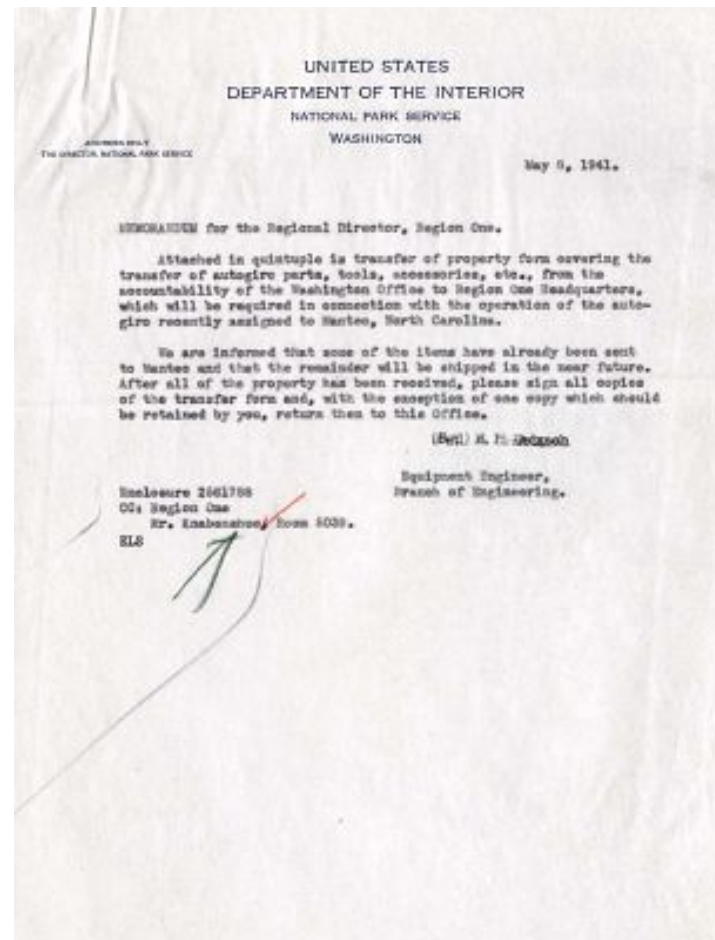
MEMORANDUM for the Regional Director, Region One.
