Dear Mr. Seligman,

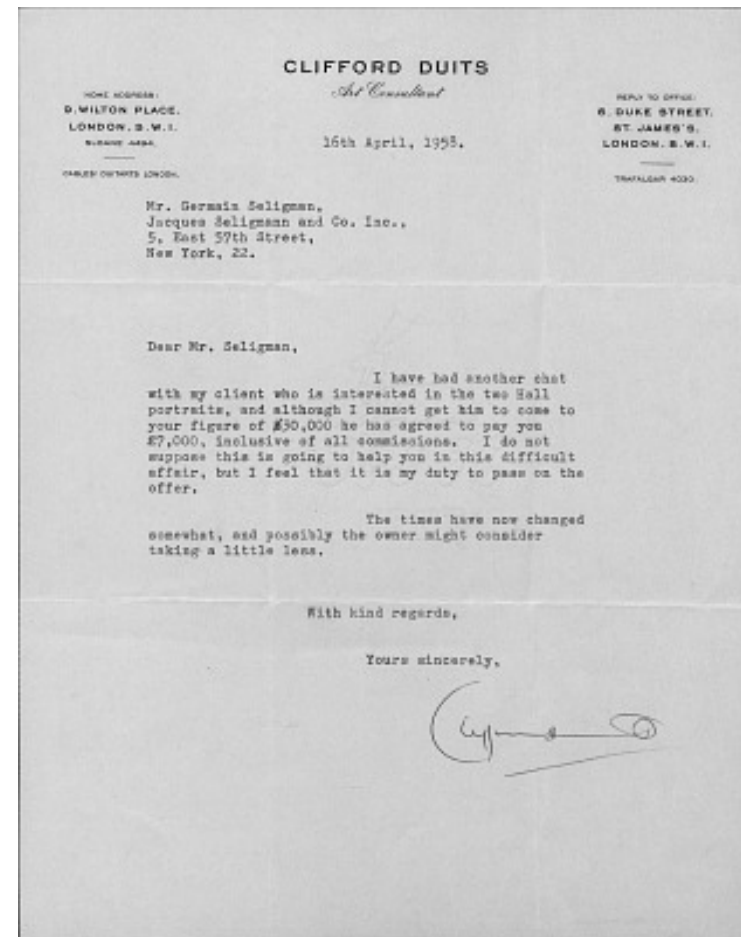
