Keep your eye open, you could get around trip ticket Friday good for 4 days - price 18 francs. You would really enjoy it here. Got in too early anyway to begin school work. Take advantage of this great weather - Be good & come here, as ever, Irving.

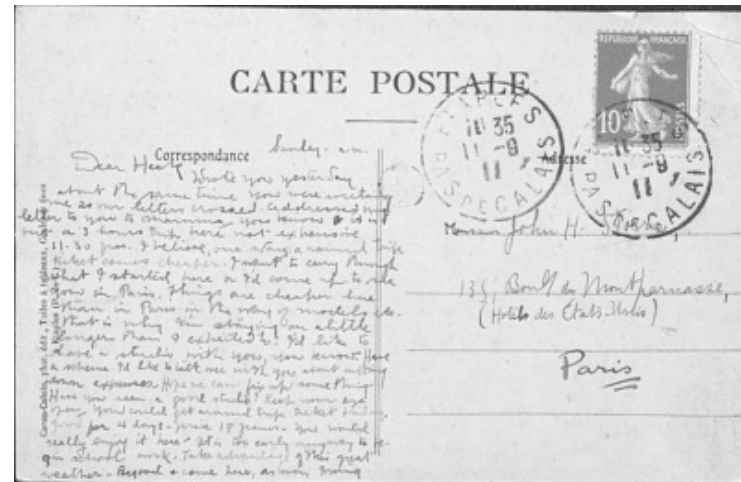
