
UNITED STATES STAMP DUTIES

BILL OF SALE OF VESSEL, or any part thereof, consideration of value not over \$500......50 Every add'l \$500, or part thereof, 50 cents more. BOND OF INDEMNITY, every \$1,000, or part thereof...50 BOND, for the execution of the duties of any office.. 1.00 BOND, other than required in legal proceedings, or used in connection CERTIFICATE OF DAMAGE, or otherwise, and all other certificates or documents issued by any port warden, marine surveyor, or person (Certificates of measurement or weight of animals, wood, coal, or hay; certificate of the record of a deed or other instrument in writing, or of the acknowledgment or proof thereof, by attesting witnesses, require no CHARTER PARTY, (or renewal &c. of same,) contract or agreement for charter of vessel or steamer of registered tonnage, not over 150 Over 600 tons...... 10.00 CONTRACT, or renewal, Broker's note, or memorandum of sale of merchandise, exchange, real estate, or other property issued by CONVEYANCE.---Deed or writing, whereby any lands, tenements, or other realty sold is granted, assigned, or transferred, for every \$500, or

UNITED STATES STAMP DUTIES.



INSURANCE against accidental injury to persons, exempt.

LEASE, ASSIGNMENT OF.---A stamp duty equal to that imposed on the original instrument, increased by a stamp duty on the consideration or value of the assignment equal to that imposed upon the conveyance of land for similar consideration or value. (See Conveyance)
