

- 1947 Thursday. hot. Zamer's in afternoon. Heard "Kraft Music Hall" Mr. Keen & wife. cut tobacco.
- 1944 Tuesday. Daddy took tobacco to Dr. Baden's barn today. Got 5 eggs.
- 1945 Wednesday. Daddy to Virginia to see about the accident. Daddy & boys to Brandywine & J.B. Charles Quade drunk wanted to see daddy. hot.
- 1946 Thursday. School opened. Went to Marboro School with Marie & Aggie. like it. cool. cut tobacco. laundry. Friday. cut tobacco. got letter from Aunt Lucy. hot.
