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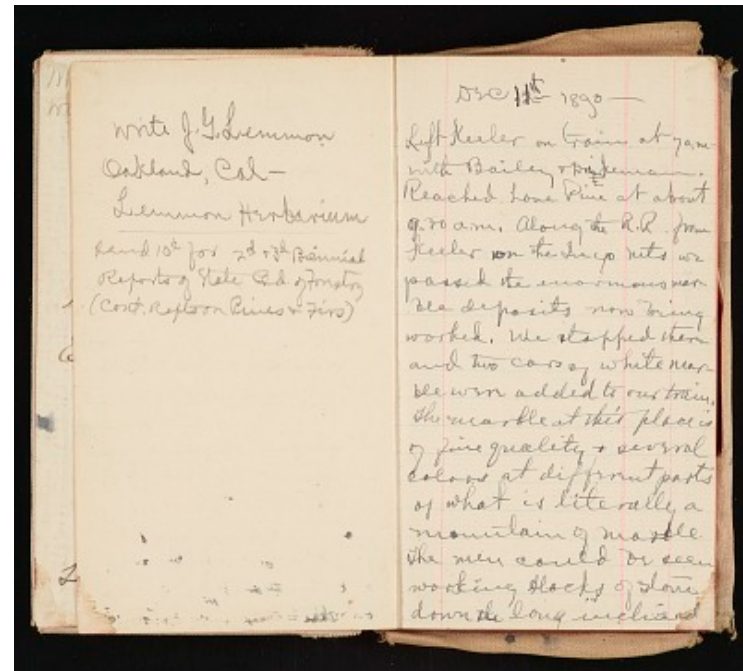

We stopped there and two cars of white marble were added to our train. The marble at this place is of fine quality & several colors at different parts of what is literally a mountain of marble.
