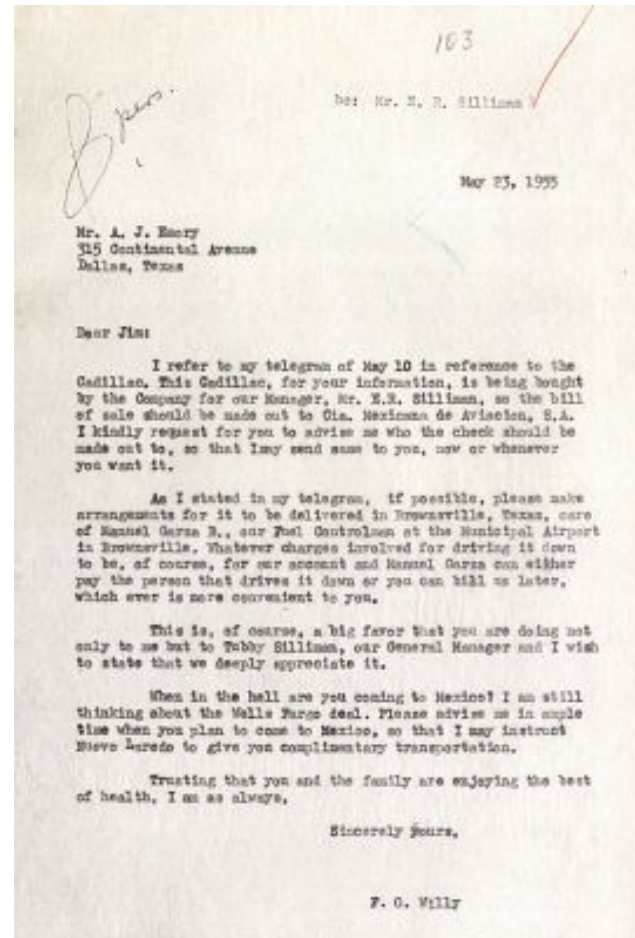
This is, of course, a big favor that you are doing not only to me but to Tubby Silliman, our General Manager and I wish to state that we deeply appreciate it.
