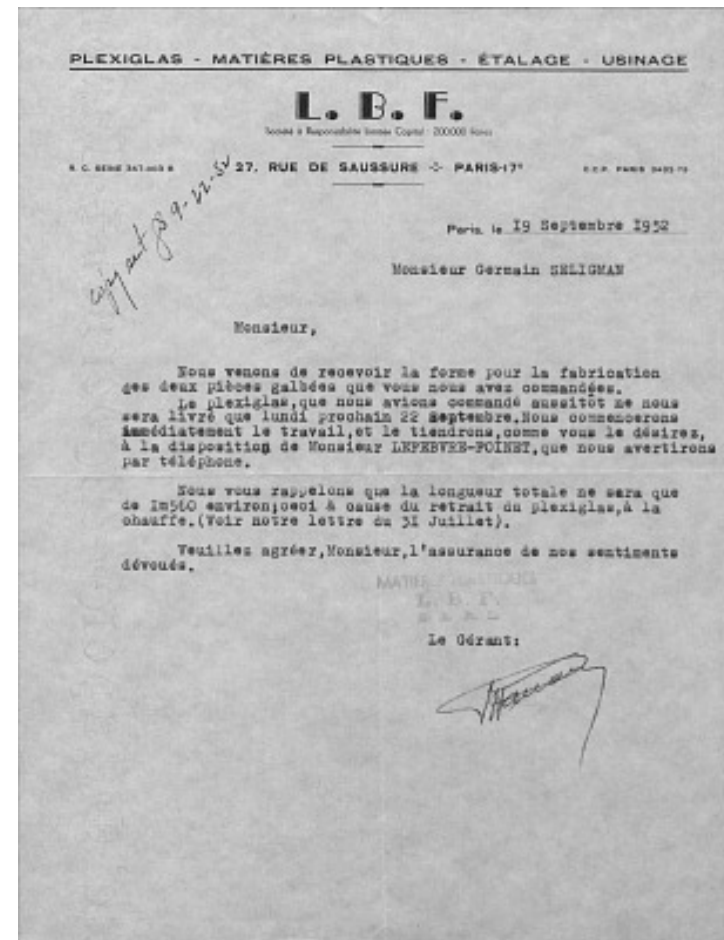
Monsieur,
