non seulement philanthropique mais aussi patriotique.

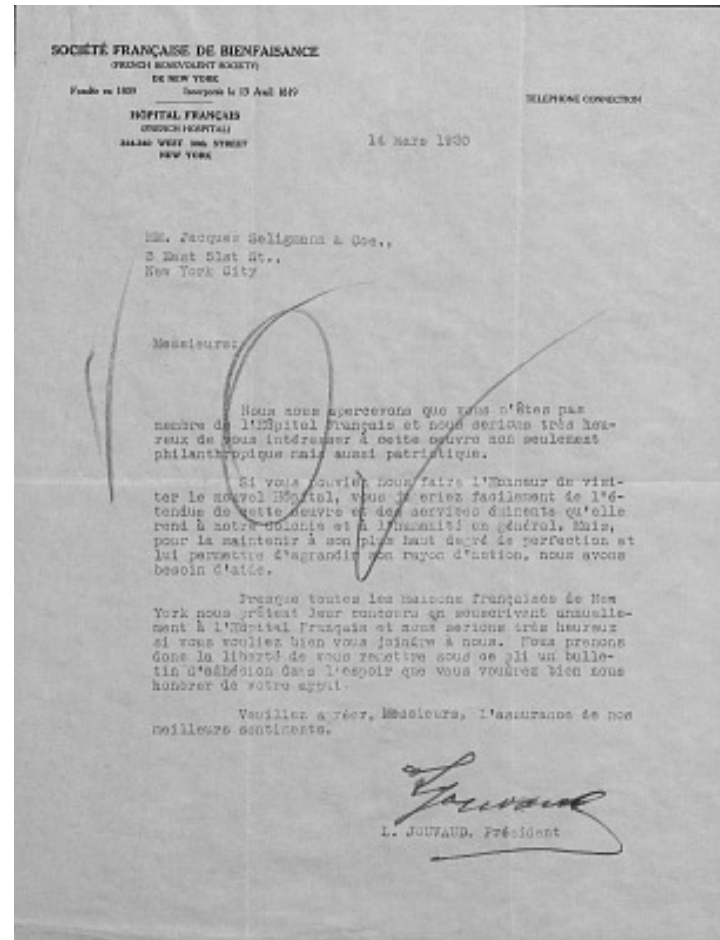
Si vous pouviez nous faire l'Honneur de visiter le nouvel Hôpital, vous ju
