Casey We have left the Marines to the last, although they are always the first to land, and I know that Buffalo is proud of one of its own sons, Norbert S. Parzynski, of the U.S. Marine Corps, who spent five months fighting the Japs at Guadacanal. In honor of those leathernecks who kicked the Japs out of the Jungle Island, we will now have the Marine Hymn.

Casey Labor, management, the Army and the Navy make up the great All-American fighting team. Merchant seamen carry the weapons of war - - the products of your toil - - to our men on the firing line.
