Airport Financial Statements. A vital need of airport management is the ability to present financial information concerning the airport in accordance with recognized business practice. In this connection the Civil Aeronautics Administration has designed two basic statements which will furnish the financial data most useful to the airport managers and owners. these are an Airport Statement of Income and Expense and an Airport Balance Sheet. Presented in this manual are recommended forms for these two financial statements, which are similar to those used in standard commercial practice, although they have been modified to meet the needs of airports effectively. The Statement of Income and Expense (Statement A) is to be used to reveal financial information about the operation of the airport during a given period. The Balance Sheet (Statement B) presents a picture of the financial condition of the airport at a given date.
