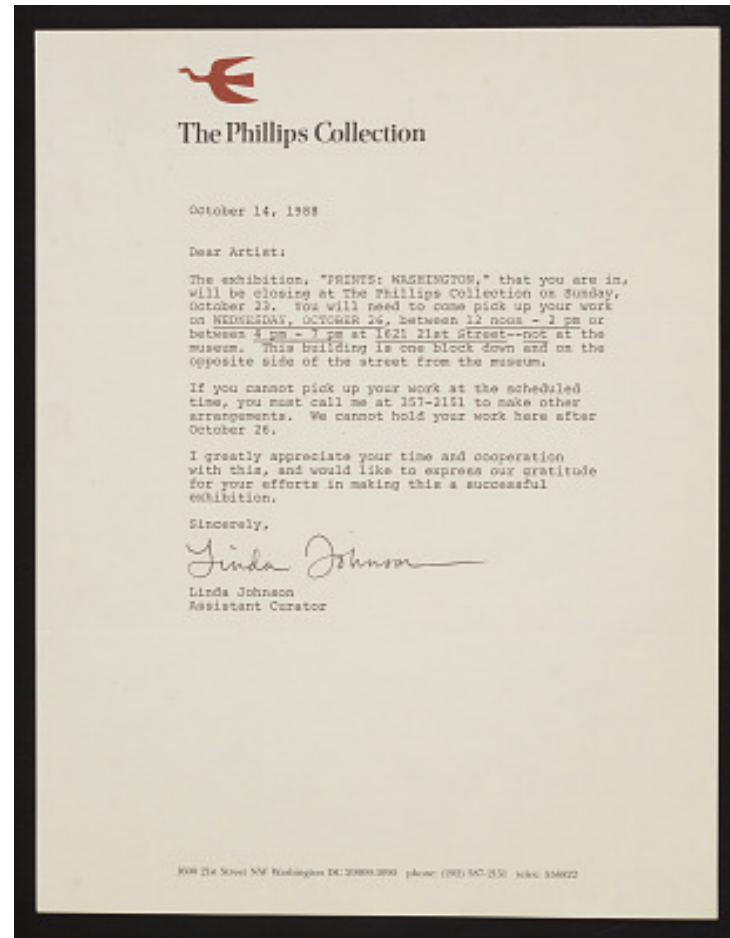
If you cannot pick up your work at the scheduled time, you must call me at 357-2151 to make other arrangements. We cannot hold your work here after October 26.
