6:45 p.m. Limousine will pick up party and bring to Reynolds Cottage for the pre-Commencement Dinner scheduled for 7:00 p.m.

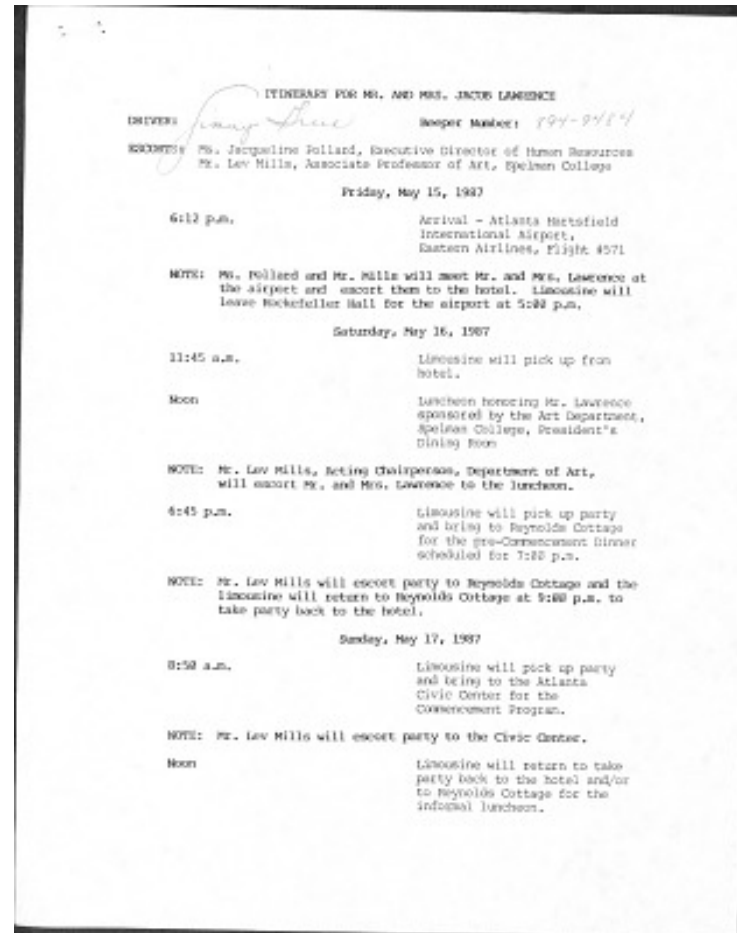
