The Regulations are as follows:  
 ALL WORKS MUST BE ORIGINAL

#### WORKS ELIGIBLE

- I. BLACK AND WHITE DRAWINGS in ink, charcoal, pencil, crayon or paint.
- II. PAINTINGS in oil, watercolor, tempera, pastel, or crayon.
- III. SCULPTURES - CARVINGS - MODELINGS in soap, clay or wood
- IV. PHOTOGRAPHY. All photographs must be mounted and may not be less than 4 x 5 inches, exclusive of the mount. NOTE: All drawings or paintings must be matted or framed. Remember "presentation counts."

#### NUMBER

Four entries in each medium may be submitted to the jury by contestants.  
 The name must be clearly printed on the back of each work.

#### DATE FOR ENTRIES

Works will be received at the Howard University Gallery of Art Friday, March 24 through Monday, March 27. No works will be received after 4:00 P. M., March 27. Works must be called for at the close of the exhibition on April 4 at the Art Department in The School of Engineering and Architecture.

#### EXHIBITION

The exhibition of prize works and others selected by the jury will be open to the public from Saturday, April 1, hours - 5 to 6 P. M.; Sunday, April 2, hours - 2 to 5; and Monday, April 3, hours - 5 to 8 P. M.

#### JURY

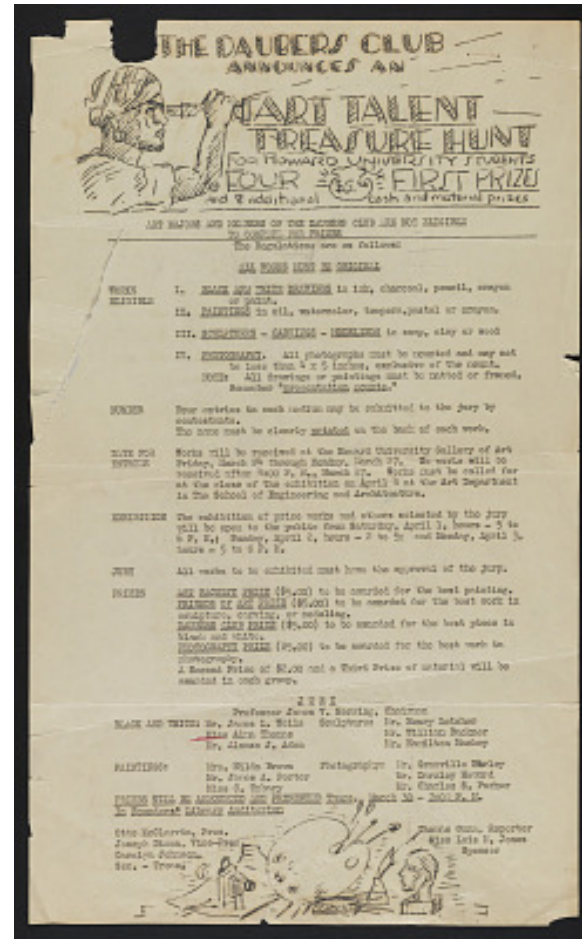
All works to be exhibited must have the approval of the jury.

#### PRIZES

ART FACULTY PRIZE (\$5.00) to be awarded for the best painting.  
 FRIENDS OF ART PRIZE (\$5.00) to be awarded for the best work in sculpture, carving, or modeling.  
 DAUBERS CLUB PRIZE (\$5.00) to be awarded for the best piece in black and white.  
 PHOTOGRAPHY PRIZE (\$5.00) to be awarded for the best work in photography.  
 A Second Prize of \$2.00 and a Third Prize of material will be awarded in each group.
