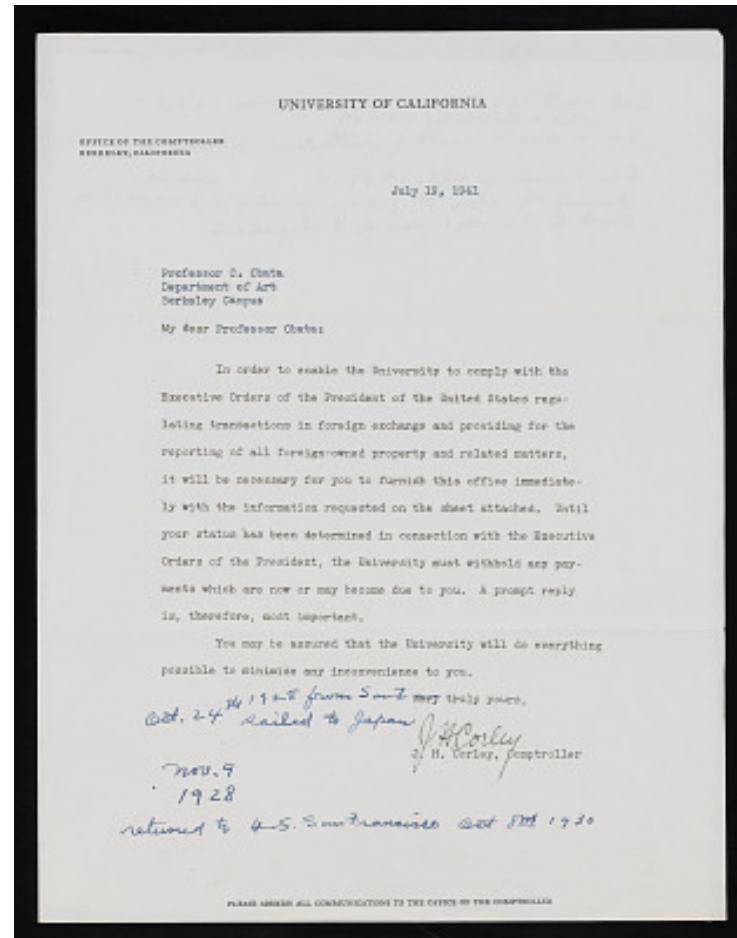
You may be assured that the University will do everything possible to minimize any inconvenience to you.
