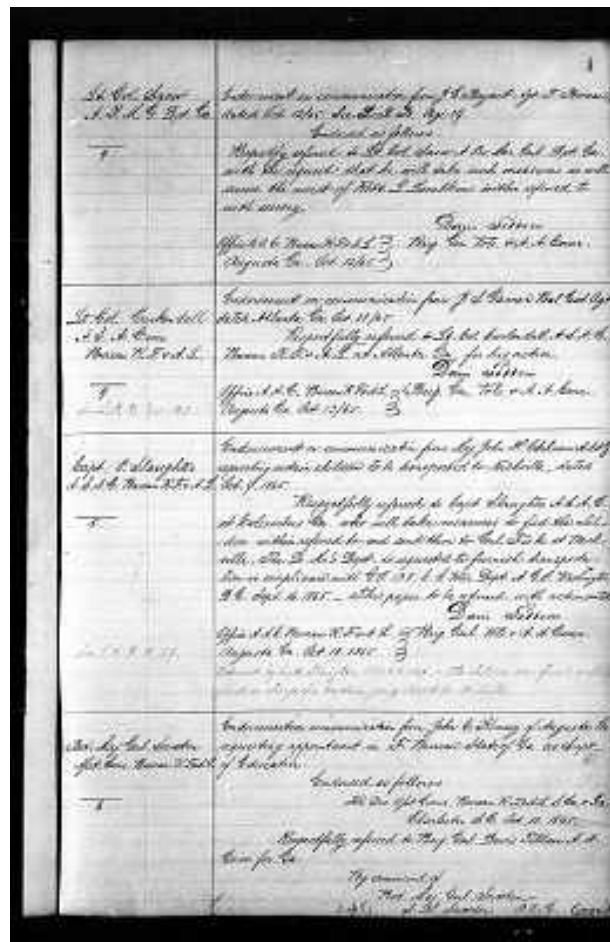
Endorsement on communication from Maj. John H. Cochran A.A.A.G. requesting certain children to be transported to Nashville, dated Oct. 9. 1865.
