Dear Mr. Sheeler:


I hardly can tell you how disappointed I was when I received your letter informing me that you are not willing to contribute to the issue of Daedalus on "Visual Arts Today", which I am editing.

When I wrote to you I had vividly in my mind a kind letter of a few years ago to the editors of The Arts in America making some generous remarks about an article on arts and sciences in that publication. Your kind comments have, in a certain way, guided me in the process of preparing the material for this issue and, to make it clear, by no means did I expect from you a"vivisection of art"as you expressed it in your letter. What I hoped to have from you was the same spirit as your letter expressed - a vigorous, direct comment of what you feel about your own work or artistic expression in general. In fact, what I hoped to have is a spontaneous response and definitely not an analytic disciplined essay.
