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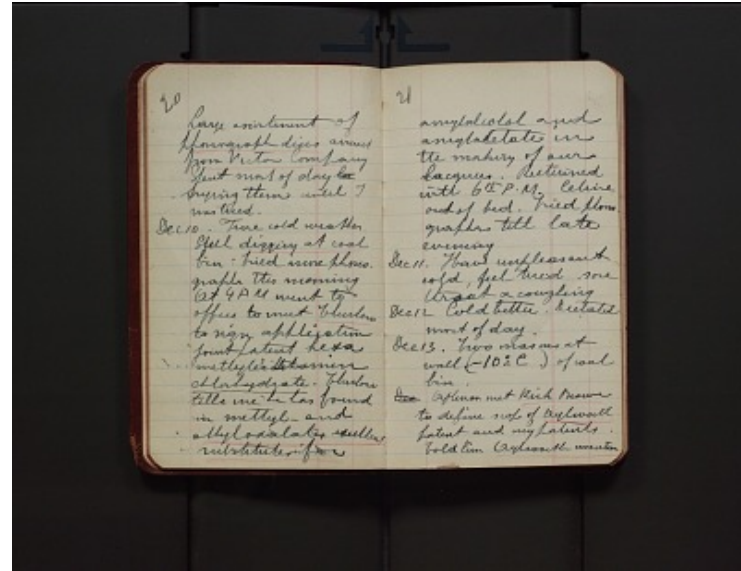
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Large assortment of phonograph discs arrived from Victor Company Spent most of day ~~lis~~ trying them until I was tired.
