In [[red underline]] library am shown my picture [[/red underline]] just published in latest issue of Journal of Society of Chemical Industry of Japan. Small cups of warm tea. - Wooden buildings are not varnished [[red underline]] because varnished wood offends artistic taste [[/red underline]] of Japanese, furthermore their buildings are [[red underline]] not supposed to last. 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
