The rate is 300\$ a month, room, café (an orange and banana with it!) and evening dinner. That is about \$1.25 a day, very reasonable. The baggage is stacked up under shelter at one side of the patio and I was allowed to take an old table into the patio to put my plants in press. I used the patio for drying the one day there has been sun. My room has running cold water. A hot bath is 2\$ (about \$.25). I am keeping clean by means of my wash bowl as yet, I'm squeamish about

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
