

June 19, 1918. again the German attack on Western Front and in Italy. but Allies resist well. The papers announce that american aviators now training in Italy have been sent to Italian front. Very probably George is amongst them. Very

June 20. Am continually thinking of George. Unfit for work. went out alone in motor car to Bear Mountain then back over West-point ~~along Auds~~ and Garrison along Hudson. Since about two weeks weather has been splendid and cool.

June 21. Left for Washington tonight. Charges for train now are \$7.91 without waiter and Pullman is 2.00.

June 22. Meeting of Naval Consulting Board at Carnegie Institution Building. Rather less interesting than usually except for report
