The jury which did not have a single Negro on it found John Williams guilty and he was sentenced to from 7 1/2 to 15 years.

At the second trial the presiding judge was the anti-Negro, anti-labor Justice Peter J. Brancato. In passing sentence, the judge declared: [italics] "I would give him 20 years if I could. Remember she is a white woman." [end italics]

On June 17, as a result of the mass fight against this northern "Scottsboro Case," John Williams was released.
