Inquires as to the course proper for him to pursue in obtaining money due him from the U.S. for services as Insp. of Election, in one of the precincts of his County in the years 1867 & 1868.

Acknowledges receipt of letter of the 15th inst. in relation to an article in the "Western Democrat" newspaper regarding the distribution of arms &c and calling his attention to the same. States that after the most careful inquiry he is satisfied that his report of the 11th inst. is correct &c. That the arms reported not only came in gun boxes but were called for as guns and designated as such by the parties to whom they were consigned were marked Carbines & Cartridges and and designated by the Express Compy. as such &c &c.
