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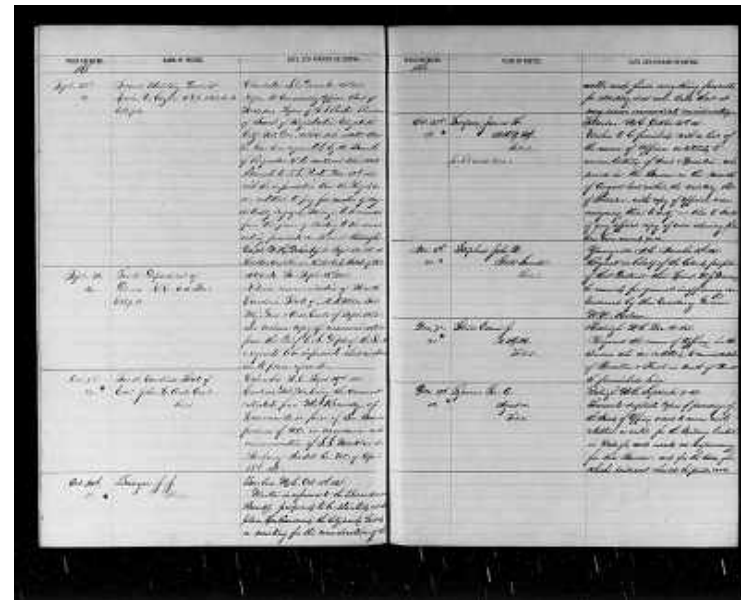

Transmits duplicate Copies of proceedings of the Board of Officers ordered to convene and establish a rental for the Building located in Raleigh and used as dispensary for this Bureau, and fix the time for which said rent should be paid &c &c.

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
