

Nov. 6th 40 * | Stephens John W. State Senator. Filed. | Yanceyville N.C. November 4th 1868. Request in behalf of the Colored people of that District that Lieut. W. J. Dawes be removed for general inefficiency &c-Endorsed by His Excellency Governor W.W. Holden.

Dec. 7" ' 41 * | Steven Edwin J. A.A.Q.M. Filed. | Raleigh N.C. Dec. 4" 1868. Requests the names of Officers in the Bureau who are entitled to commutation of Quarters & Fuel in month of Nov. 68 be furnished him

Dec. 19^hth 42. * | Spooner Geo. O. Agent &c. Filed. | Raleigh N. C. September 7" 1868. Transmits duplicate Copies of proceedings of the Board of Officers ordered to convene and establish a rental for the Building located in Raleigh and used as dispensary for this Bureau, and fix the time for which said rent should be paid &c &c.

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
