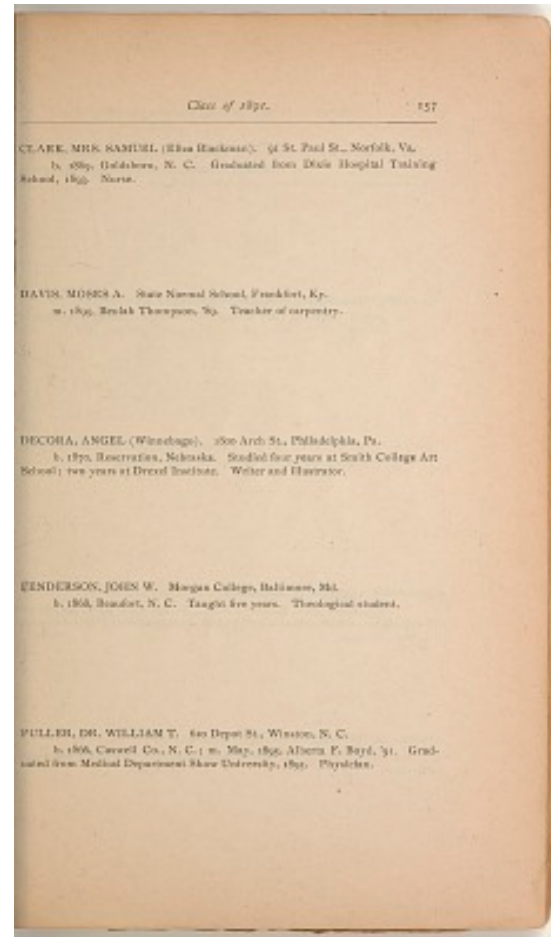
CLARK, MRS. SAMUEL (Eliza Blackman). 91 St. Paul St., Norfolk, Va.
