Will you also transmit this information to Mr. François Gerard Seligmann, who asked Mr. Georges Seligmann about this subject.

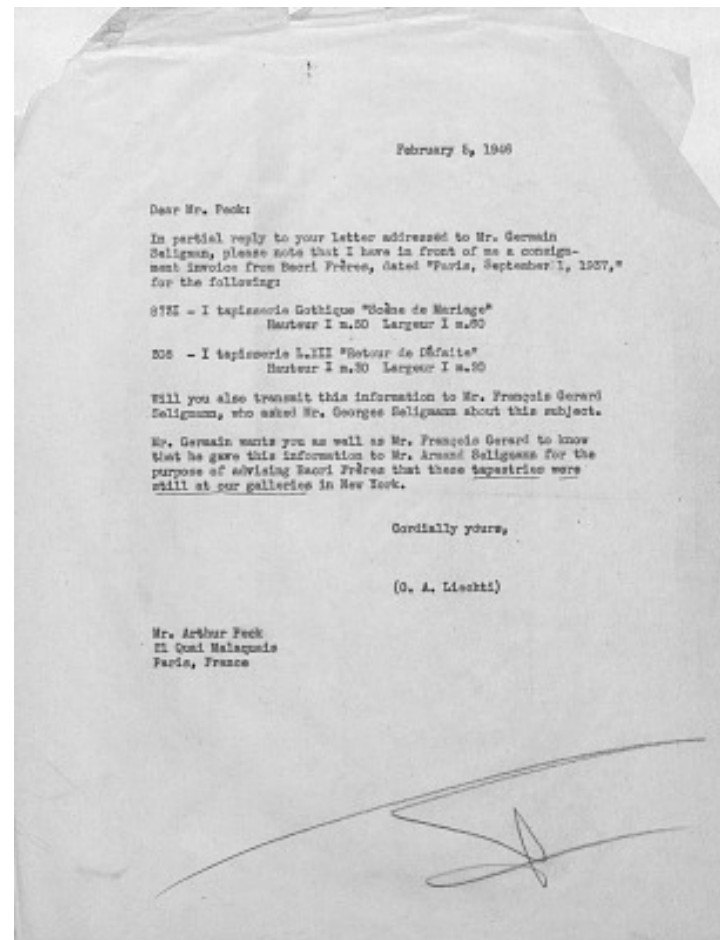
