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5.7.35 afternoon Dunkerron Castle, SK.
2.30 - 5.0 PM grounds in front of castle, logs, stumps &c, path to the sea through fields, marsh near the sea, & sea-weed on coast. [[underlined]] Bombus lapidarius [[/underlined]] 1 [[female symbol]] [[again?]] seen in field near house.
[[underlined]] B. lucorum & agrorum [[/underlined]] seen.
[[underlined]] Halictus albipes [[/underlined]] [[female symbol]] on [[underlined]] Veronica chamaedrys [[/underlined]], examined.



[[female symbol]] taken on log by old castle.

[[underlined]] Opius [[/underlined]] lugens ? [[female symbol]] [[insertion]] [[line]] ? [[/insertion]] on Nasturtium beside house. [[underlined]] Aspilota [[/underlined]] "sp. 4 like 5" ? [[male symbol]]. [[underlined]] Dacnusa areolaris [[/underlined]] abundant.

[[line across page]] [[underlined]] 1 taken amongst sea-weed on

[[underlined]] Platymischus dilatatus [[/underlined]] [[male symbol]] & [[female symbol]] taken in cop. on shore: during love-making the [[male symbol]] sweeps his antennae across those of [[female symbol]] who then turns hers over her head & places the apical joint of hers in the hollow under the dilated scape of the [[male symbol]] from which action both seem to enjoy intense satisfaction!

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
