Dear Mr. Valentin:

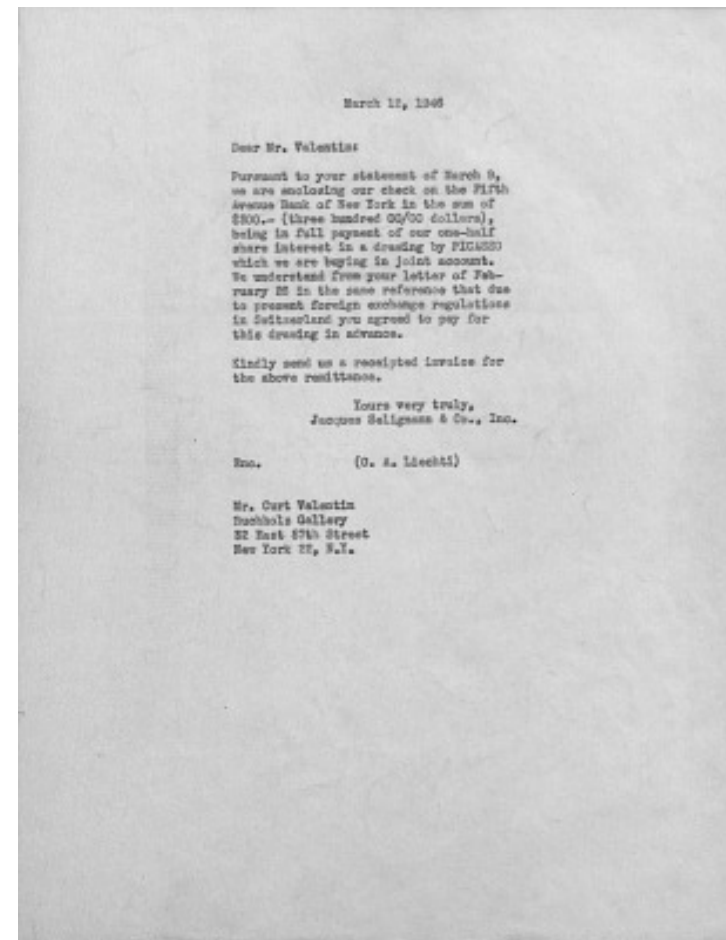
