Unless I hear from you to the contrary, I will assume that this painting will be insured by you.

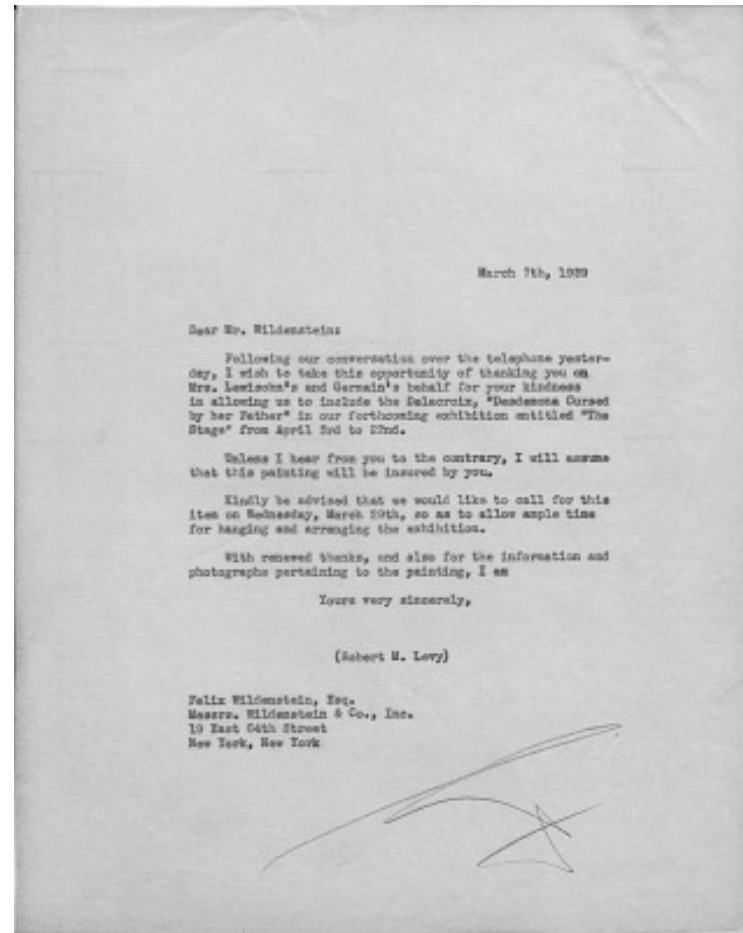
Kindly be advised that we would like to call for this item on Wednesday, March 29th, so as to allow ample time for hanging and arranging the exhibition.
