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### [[column one]] HEALTH AND TIME

Days and years . . . Patients spent 5,908,421 days in these hospitals last year, the equivalent of over 162 centuries.

Needy sick, who could pay nothing, or but little for their care, received 1,878,801 free days of care. This free care, which the hospitals gave for the protection of the health of each of us, was an increase of twelve and one-half per cent over the previous year.

These free days of hospital care, given to protect us all in health, cost the hospitals \$9,534,812. [[/column one]]

[[column two]] HEALTH AND PEOPLE

One in every twenty of New York's 7,363,624 persons received bed care in the voluntary hospitals last year. 1,070,944 persons visited out-patient departments of these hospitals seeking diagnosis and care.

Organized care of the sick is carried beyond the hospital walls by medical social service, convalescent care, and home care, as recommended in the Hospital Survey for New York.
